Aberdeen Christian School has some students with severe life-threatening peanut allergies. The allergy is so severe that if they come in contact with peanuts/nuts they could die. **We are a peanut-free school!** If your child is a Pre K – Grade 1 student who brings snacks to school, please do not bring anything that contains peanuts or peanut oil in the ingredients. For all students who will be eating lunch at school anytime this school year, please do not allow your child to bring anything that may contain these ingredients!! We do sanitize the lunchroom tables with special chemicals each day.

The students who have these life-threatening allergies do a great job of being careful in our school and know what foods to avoid. Your cooperation is appreciated and will help prevent an accidental death of a child. If you have any questions or concerns, please call the school office at 225-2053.

It is that time again...for returning ACS families, you know the drill. This information is meant as a reminder for those returning and offering the basics on the school's program for the new families. It's pretty simple....start saving your receipts from KESSLERS, KENS, and ECONO. That means not only grocery receipts...but any GAS receipts from Kens, and PHARMACY receipts from Kesslers and Econo. The receipts **can't be dated any earlier than 9-1-2010**. Simply stated: No receipts over this past summer (including any receipts from last month (August) can't be turned in. They will just be thrown out. Please try to turn the receipts in on a regular basis. There are 3 marked plastic containers placed on top of the coat rack by the office where you can place the proper receipts in the proper containers. Feel free to send bagged receipts (separated by store) with your child who can turn them in to his/her teacher. **DO NOT** staple, nor add up the receipts. We appreciate the intended help, but we have to follow a system set by the stores. The total amount turned in last year was just over \$252,000.00. The school's PTF received approx 1% of that amount. Let's try to match that this year, or better yet...surpass it!!! Thanks to all who have participated in the past...and to the new families: **WELCOME!!**
