ASVAB TESTING INFORMATION

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery is the most widely used multiple-aptitude test battery in the world. The <u>ASVAB</u> measures your strengths, weaknesses and potential for future success in four domains: verbal, math, science and technical, and spatial.

The ASVAB includes tests in 10 areas: general science (GS), arithmetic reasoning (AR), word knowledge (WK), paragraph comprehension (PC), mathematics knowledge (MK), electronics information (EI), auto information (AI), shop information (SI), mechanical comprehension (MC) and assembling objects (AO). It provides career information for various civilian and military occupations and is an indicator for success in future endeavors, such as college, vocational school or a military career. Any individual interested in enlisting in the Armed Forces and in 10th-12th grade may take the ASVAB.

The ASVAB is administered by the United States Military Entrance Processing Command, and utilized to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. Aberdeen Christian School Juniors take the ASVAB each fall. Contact Mrs. Harms for more information.
